

Participatory Infrastructure Management I/NGOs engagement in P135-II

1. Experience and lessons-learned from I/NGOs

Save Children UK:

- have projects for ECD in Dao, San Chi, Thai, Mong, ... communities
- sharing: documented experience in projects

Plan International:

- 50% of budget for infrastructure: irrigation, health centre, schools
- has methodology for community management project (e.g. community does the construction -> cost reduced and community manages the techniques)
- Sharing: model of community management project and child-friendly construction model

World Vision:

- 20% budget for infrastructure in communities (water, irrigation, schools...)

Church World Service:

- 50% of budget for infrastructure
- activities: classroom, water supply, sanitation (10% of expense come from districts, communes, schools)
- procedure: apply Vietnam government procedure in construction but keep involved in all steps
- participation beneficiary: people are encouraged to participate in all steps, from planning, monitoring ... to maintaining
- sharing: training manual and study tour in Thai Nguyen

IOM

- migration, trafficking, human rights
- sharing: caravan method

CISDOMA

- have different projects in building infrastructure for communities
- sharing: experience in construction management and maintenance

SNV:

- community forestry management, capacity building, new energy, watsan constructions
- capacity building for infrastructure building at commune level
- Sharing: experience on infrastructure in other countries (Nepal,...)

Oxfam Hong Kong:

- 50% of budget for infrastructure: irrigation, water sanitation

- has experience in implementation and maintenance of construction (have supervision group, maintenance training, regulation for fund)
- sharing: construction model

Care International:

- capacity building for community-based organizations and networking among groups for livelihood improvement
- Sharing: experience and document in slopping agriculture land technique model

Oxfam GB:

- infrastructure in Lao Cai and Ha Tinh: irrigation
- Sharing: documents on experience and lesson learned
